

How we use cookies

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To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies?

Merlin uses cookies to offer you a better browsing experience. A number of our pages use cookies to remember:

- Your printing preferences, such as computer name and computerId
- You need to allow cookies or set an exception for this server to use Merlin. We use cookies on your computer to tell us when you're signed in. To learn how to allow cookies, check the online help in your web browser or contact Vet Space support. For Chrome: Options > Settings > Show Advanced Options: Under Privacy - click 'Content settings...', on the next page under 'Cookies' select 'Allow local data to be set (recommended)' and click the done button.
- if you have already allowed the cookie notice pop-up, you won't be asked again
- The cookie-related information is not used to identify you personally and the pattern data is fully under our control. These cookies are not used for any purpose other than those described here.
- Enabling these cookies is necessary for our application to work and it will provide you with a better browsing experience. You can delete or block these cookies, but if you do that some features of this site may not work as intended.

How to control cookies

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see aboutcookies.org. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.
